The CEP has a long history of protecting the rights of our members.

This struggle for protection and dignity for all workers is just as important for CEP construction members.

Over the past year, some other unions have opposed our members' right to work with CEP construction employers. Most recently, the Construction and Specialized Workers Union Local 1611 (the Labourers Union) distributed a threatening letter to its members stating that their membership in Local 1611 will be harmed unless they cease working on CEP construction jobs.

The CEP feels that this harassment is illegal and a horribly anti-union thing for any worker to do to another.

At the CEP, we believe that workers should belong to as many unions as possible. Holding memberships in more than one union is good for workers and good for our communities. After all, only 30% of Canada is unionized and we all need more union power, not less. We say workers should be more active in more unions.

Therefore, please be advised that the CEP has already taken legal and political action against CSWU Local 1611, and will do whatever it takes to protect our member's right to hold multiple union memberships and to lead a harassment-free life with access to quality jobs.
